

Crisis Responder - Volunteer

Caledon\Dufferin Victim Services is a not-for-profit, charitable organization serving the Town of Caledon and the County of Dufferin. We are a police based, volunteer driven organization offering 24 hour, 7 day a week short-term crisis support, practical assistance, information and referral to victims of crime, tragic circumstance and disaster. We are presently recruiting for **Crisis Response Volunteer**.

Duties & Responsibilities

- Respond to dispatched calls by going on site or by telephone
 - Be available and reachable during shifts and respond immediately to requests for assistance
 - o Report to the Communications Coordinator before, during and after every call
 - Complete Client Contract Report forms in a timely manner
 - o Follow the Caledon Dufferin Victim Services Code of Conduct.
- Help victims to understand the physical and emotional impact of the crisis reaction
 - Assess for safety at all times
 - o Identify needs and provide referrals and provide support and assistance
 - Be professional in behaviour and appearance
 - Interact with clients in a non-judgmental and empathetic way, validating feelings and offering appropriate options
- Provide referrals to community agencies and connect individuals with appropriate assistance and support programs

Training

- 40 hours of combined electronic learning modules and in class training
- · Ongoing coaching, mentoring and monthly learning sessions

Qualifications

- Empathetic and non-judgmental
- Excellent interpersonal, problem solving and communication skills
- Open to learning new skills and able to build on existing skills
- Able to work in a team and independently self starter
- Maturity, self-confidence and a healthy mental/emotional state
- Flexible schedule
- Clean police record check

Requirements

- Consent to a Release of Information which allows police to perform various criminal records checks including a Vulnerable Persons Sector Screening
- Swear an Oath of Confidentiality with the Ontario Provincial Police and with Caledon\Dufferin Victim Services
- Complete required training and attend monthly meetings
- Possess a valid driver's license, insurance and a reliable vehicle
- Maintenance of confidentiality is of extreme importance

Benefits

- Reimbursement for out of pocket expenses and travel is provided, as approved and applicable on a monthly basis
- Receive ongoing debriefing, support and counselling when needed

Limitations

- Volunteers must live in the Town of Caledon or County of Dufferin to volunteer
- Volunteer Crisis Responders will not transport clients or be responsible for the care of minors or those in need of medical attention
- All client contact is directed by Caledon Dufferin Victim Services

Term of Assignment

- Commitment to the minimum of three, 12 hour shifts per month
- Provide a minimum of one year of service
- Attending monthly Volunteer Meetings and required workshops
